Wine on Tap Listing

Wine that tastes good comes down to two things—good quality wine and keeping the wine fresh. ... Wine on tap means the first glass poured is as fresh as the last.

White Varietals

Eola Hills Riesling, Oregon

Primarily Cinsault grapes, blended with Grenache, Syrah, and Merlot, this gorgeous rose has a bouquet of red berries and white flowers with tasting hints of blood orange and red currant, and spicy vanilla on the back half.

2020 Scarpetta Pinot Grigio, Friuli Venezia Giulia, Italy

This pinot grigio has a light straw color with a hint of salmon and is aged on the lees for 6 months in stainless steel. This wine has a creamy texture to support floral, peach and apricot aromatics, with stone fruits, white flowers, pear and crushed stones on the palate.

Hess Shirttail Ranch, Chardonnay, Monterey County

The nose is inviting with kiwi, candied lemon peel and vanilla aromas leading to flavors of juicy ripe pear and golden delicious apple. This Chardonnay has a pleasing kiss of oak delivering flavors of toasted almond and nougat which add interest to its medium-body, and long finish

Loveblock Sauvignon Blanc, Certified Organic, New Zealand

It has a pale straw color with a hint of green and gold (Go Pack!). It has a complex and elegant Sauvignon Blanc bouquet, with pineapple, guava and sweet meadow grass aromas. It also is rounded and textured, with pineapple, tropical fruit and a sweet basil edge followed by ripe peach on the back palate. It's chalky minerality and complexity complements the fruit.

Red Varietals

Ercavio Tempranillo, Spain

Inky purple in color. Expressive aromas of dark fruit: black cherry, plum and blueberry mixed with a pleasant minerality, hints of cedar, vanilla, liquorice, spice and espresso. Medium bodied, yet dense this wine offers ripe tannins under a complex blanket of black fruit. The acidity is well balanced and the finish is long and velvety.

Spellbound, Petite Sirah - California

Spellbound Petite Sirah has an intense color and generous bouquet of rich blackberries and blueberries, vanilla bean and roasted coffee, all in a remarkably approachable glass. The wine is crafted to unleash dark and luscious characteristics, while managing tannins to deliver an opulent and juicy Petite Sirah.

2017 Saint Francis Cabernet Sauvignon, Sonoma County, California

This 100% Cabernet Sauvignon is a full bodied wine with a bold and creamy taste. It starts with a rich, blackberry, and blackcurrant on the nose that leads to a velvety palate, followed by cedar, tobacco, spice and earthy tones and finishes with softer tannins on the palate.

2019 Argyle Pinot Noir, Willamette Valley, Oregon AVA

This vintage of Argyle Pinot Noir has flavors of red cherry, pomegranate and spiced tea. It boasts fresh, vibrant acidity with polished tannins and a silky texture. It is aged in 60% stainless steel, 40% neutral barrel. It is a certified sustainable wine meaning they have a winemaking process that protects the environment, supports social responsibility, maintains economic feasibility, and produces high quality wines.
